This course aims to engage students in an independent research under individual supervision on a reading, research and/or creative project. The student will conduct an in-depth scholarly study in an area not covered in the other HUM and CPW courses.

The Independent Study trains independent research and critical skills through an intensive study on a pertinent topic in the field of Humanities and affords the opportunity to exercise students' initiative. Regular supervision meeting between the student and the supervisor is expected.
